NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Sun Prairie Utilities Commission has filed applications with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (Commission) to amend our electric and water operating rules as they apply to deferred payment agreement offerings to residential customers who are tenants. **This application applies to residential tenant customers only.**

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0809(9) and the Commission's final order in docket 5-EI-152, **Sun Prairie Utilities will not offer a deferred payment agreement to a residential customer who is a tenant if any of the following criteria applies:**

1. The residential tenant has defaulted on a deferred payment agreement in the past 12 months. This criterion only applies to deferred payment agreements and not to other types of payment extensions or agreements.
2. The residential tenant is responsible for account arrearages that were placed on any property owner's tax bill in the utility's service territory in the past 24 months.
3. The residential tenant has a balance that accrued during the winter moratorium that is more than 80 days past due.

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin will hold a public hearing in this proceeding on Wednesday, March 25, 2015, at 1:30 p.m., in the Amnicon Falls Hearing Room at the Public Service Commission Building, 610 North Whitney Way, Madison, Wisconsin, and by **telephone** at Sun Prairie Utilities, 125 West Main Street, Sun Prairie Wisconsin.
